



CALL FOR VISUAL ART ENTRIES!

V-Day, founded by playwright Eve Ensler, is a worldwide movement to raise awareness and end violence against women and girls. V-Day Petaluma 2009, an event that includes a performance of “The Vagina Monologues”, will benefit Sonoma County YWCA Women’s Safe House and Domestic Violence Services, as well as B.R.A.V.E. People’s services for women.

As part of V-Day Petaluma 2009, we are seeking local artists to create a piece in the medium of their choice that is a positive expression of what the V-Day movement means to them, including alters (paying homage to a survivor or victim of violence, or groups of women such as the women of the Congo), or artwork relating to women’s empowerment and prevention of violence against women and girls. Artists are encouraged to visit the V-Day website, www.vday.org, for an understanding of the movement.

To promote the movement, our goal is to display pieces throughout the community prior to the event. Pieces will later be displayed at Petaluma Community Center during the event, March 13 and 14. Pieces will be returned to the artist unless they offer to place them in our silent auction.
